Fire Safety and Evacuation:

Matches likes to sleep through the fire drills his family plans. It's no big deal, his house will never catch on fire anyway!

Always be prepared
for a fire or
emergency. You are
better off safe than
sorry.**

Don't be like Matches! Encourage your family to follow these safety precautions!

1. Install and maintain smoke detectors and fire extinguishers.
2. Plan and practice fire drills with all family members using alternate means of escape, including not being able to use the main exit.
3. There should be two means of escape far away from each other.
4. Your family should know the location of smoke detectors and of portable fire extinguishers in your home.
5. If you smell smoke, a smoke detector sounds, or a fire is found:
 - 1) Get out side and stay out don't go back in for anything.
 - 2) Go to your meeting place (your meeting place should be the same place all the time and be part of your home fire drill)
 - 3) Dial 9-1-1 from a neighbor's phone or a cell phone not from the house with the fire!
