DECK & WOOD Cleaner/Restorer

Description

DWR Cleaner is a ready to use, biodegradable product for cleaning and restoring exterior, natural wood surfaces; including cedar, redwood, pressure treated, pine and oak fencing, decks and siding. It is an environmentally safe product that provides excellent results economically. It does not contain any bleach, chlorinated solvents, acids or any ozone depleting ingredients.

Uses

Use Cleaner/Restorer in place of ineffective bleach products or hazardous solvent based compounds. It is a proven cleaner/restorer for graying and discolored wood caused by moisture, mold, mildew, tannin, UV damage, dirt, natural weathering and aging.

Preparation & Application

Cleaner/Restorer may be applied by brush, roller or pump-style sprayer. Prior to application, remove all furniture, metal fixtures and children's toys from the area. Thoroughly wet down plants and vegetation before and after application to avoid damage. Do not apply to hot surfaces or in direct sunlight. Apply to a cool, dry surface. Apply cleaner/restorer liberally to the surface with recommended applicator. On vertical surfaces, start from the bottom. Wait approximately 5 minutes, agitate surface and rinse or power-wash. If cleaner dries, spray with water or re-apply cleaner. Re-apply if necessary to achieve desired results.

Use Organic Brightener and Neutralizer to brighten wood that may darken more than expected, especially cedar and redwood and to neutralize any remaining cleaner.

Wait until surface is thoroughly dry before applying stain or clear protectant. Lightly sanding surface will remove residual wood fibers and help coating penetration and adhesion.
