**Special Fire Fighting Procedures:**

**4. Reactivity Data**

<b>Stability:</b>	Stable
<b>Conditions to Avoid:</b>	Temperatures above 400° F
<b>Hazardous by Products:</b>	C0, C02, NH3, amines, styrene, divinylbenzene
<b>Materials to avoid contact with:</b>	Strong oxidizing agents (i.e. nitric acid)
<b>Hazardous Polymerization:</b>	Material does not polymerize
<b>Storage:</b>	Store in a cool dry place

**5. Health Hazards & Sara (Right to Know)**

<b>Emergency First Aid Procedures:</b>	Contact with eyes can and skins can cause irritation. Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes.
<b>Carcinogenicity:</b>	Not Applicable
<b>Sara – title 3, sections 311 &amp; 312:</b>	All ingredients are non-hazardous

**6. Control Measures**

<b>Respiratory protection:</b>	Not required for normal uses if irritation occurs from breathing-get fresh air!
<b>Eye protection:</b>	Splash goggles
<b>Ventilation:</b>	Normal
<b>Protective Gloves:</b>	Not required.

**7. Safe handling procedures**

<b>In Case of Spills:</b>	Sweep up material and transfer to containers. Use caution – the floor will be slippery!
